5. REPORTS FROM DEPARTMENTS/COMMITTEES

5.1 FINANCES - F-11-2021 - Report on Building Department Fees as of December 31, 2020.

5.4 GENERAL MANAGEMENT - DG-19-2021 - Size of Municipal Council.

The Chief Administrative Officer presents his report and the three options offered to Council. Council members have many questions:

Is it possible to also consider the possibility of eliminating the wards or to modify the boundaries? They all agree with the proposed option to eliminate two councillor positions.

The Chief Administrative Officer explains that the process to reduce the number of councillors is easily done, with a resolution of Council. However, for the wards, it is much more complicated and is subject to appeals in front of the Local Planning Tribunal.

Directive is given to the administration to proceed with a public consultation about the possibility of reducing the number of councillors to four, for the upcoming 2022 municipal elections.

Notice of the public consultation will be announced in the local newspapers, as well as our social medias and Telmatik.

5.5 ENGINEERING - ENG-02-2021 - State of the Core Infrastructure- Village of Plantagenet.

The municipal engineer, Mr. Jonathan Gendron, presents his report. He recommends a 5 years moratorium for the village of Plantagenet, as the lagoon has reached its maximum capacity. This moratorium would allow time to complete the studies and the remedial work needed for the lagoon.

After discussion, Council wishes to allow for a maximum of 50 additional capacities, offered on the basis of first come first served.

With respect to the accessory dwelling units, Council agrees that they will be subject to a request, processed on case-by-case basis, and that the units granted for these apartments will count in the 50 capacities discussed above.
